Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject noted above, I am directed to grant recognition to your school from class Ist to VIII (without aid) w.o.f. academic session 1988-89 subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules, 1973 framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed and preference shall be given to the students of Najafgarh area.
3. That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff for all the classes of the school as per the present norms of the department.
4. That the school shall equip the Science Lab. as per the norms of the department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students. More material worth Rs.2000/- shall be purchased.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per ratio of 10 books per student may be added and facilities of reading room may also be provided immediately and more books worth Rs.8000/- may be purchased by the start of next session.
6. That adequate sports materials shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately. ~~More~~ sports materials worth Rs.2000/- shall be purchased ~~every~~ year.


7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973 and payment shall be made as per section 10(1) of DSEA, 1973 to all the employees.
8. That the enrolment in each section shall not exceed the number of students accommodated @ 12 sq. ft. per student for the available floor area of the class-room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of the existing sections should not exceed the number of the class room of proper size in the school.
9. That the school/society shall obtain land from the DBA for the unaided school and benefits/privileges of aided schools shall not be used for the purpose of unaided school. Entrance Gate of both the school shall be made separately so that the character of both the schools may not be mixed up with each other.
10. That no fee shall be enhanced during 1988-89.
11. That additional accommodation as per undertaking shall be constructed during Summer Vacations.
12. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over aged staff, if any, immediately.
13. That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
14. That all the facilities prescribed under Rules 50 and 51 of the Delhi School Education Rules, 1973 shall be made available to the students. Provisions of Rules 6, 7 and 9 be strictly observed.
15. That the arrangement of good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately.
16. That the Management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five thousand) only in a joint account in the name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the school in any scheduled bank within a month.

17. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/ rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school and class IX shall not be opened without the prior approval of the Director of Education, Delhi.
18. That the Health Certificate be obtained from the Competant authority, if not instand so far.
19. That a report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled shall be sent to the Education Officer every six month and return under Rule 180 of Delhi School Education Rules, 1973 shall be furnished to the Education Officer.


